

**Municipal District of Acadia #34
In the Province of Alberta**

BYLAW # 2015 / 744

A bylaw to provide for the imposition of penalties on unpaid property taxes.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Amendment Act, 1995 and amendments thereto, provides that a Council may impose penalties on unpaid taxes;

AND WHEREAS, the Council considers it expedient to impose penalties on unpaid taxes;

THEREFORE; the Council of the Municipal District of Acadia #34, duly assembled, enact as follows;

1. That all property taxes of the Municipal District of Acadia #34 are deemed imposed on January 1 of each year.
2. That all property taxes of the Municipal District of Acadia #34 shall be due and payable in full, on or before the 15th day of November of each and every year.
3. A **penalty rate of twelve (12%) percent** shall be imposed on the 16th day of November in each year on property taxes remaining unpaid after the 15th day of November in the current year and on any taxes remaining unpaid from previous years.
4. Should the 15th day of November in any year be a weekend or a statutory holiday, the tax payable date shall be the next business day with the penalty imposed the day following.
5. This bylaw and any subsequent amendments to this bylaw shall remain in force from 2016 until repealed.
6. GENERAL:
 - Bylaw #679 is hereby repealed;
 - This bylaw shall come into force on January 1st, 2016.
