A.1.1.1.1.(5)(a) Farm and Acreage Buildings

Farm and acreage buildings include but are not limited to produce storage facilities, livestock and poultry housing, milking centres (except as required by Section 7.4), manure storage facilities, grain bins, silos, feed preparation centres, farm workshops, and horse riding, exercise and training facilities not used by the public. Farm buildings may be classed as low or high human occupancy, depending on the occupant load.

- does not contain residential occupancy
- located on land used as a farm
- has a low occupant load, used by the farmer(s), family or farm employees

Used for

- Housing livestock
- Storing, sorting, grading or bulk packaging primary agricultural products
- Housing, storing or maintaining machinery associated with the operation of the farm on which it is located

Farm Buildings are required to have the following permits issued:
